WHOLE ABDOMEN SONOGRAPHY

The liver is normal in size, shape and echotexture. Intrahepatic biliary tree and venous radicals are normal. No focal lesion seen. The portal vein and C.B.D. appear normal.

The gall bladder is well distended, with normal wall thickness & is nonlithiasic.

Pancreas and spleen are normal in size, shape and echotexture.

Both kidneys are normal in size, shape & position. The renal outlines are smooth. About 2.6 cm size **cortical cyst** seen in lower pole of right kidney. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. No evidence of hydronephrosis or calculi on both sides. Both ureters are undilated.

Abdominal aorta and I.V.C. are normal.

No lymphadenopathy or ascites. Both pleural angles are clear.

The urinary bladder is well distended (300ml), with normal wall thickness & is nonlithiasic.

Prostate is mildly enlarged in size measures about 5.2 x 3.3 x 3.4 cm (wt. 29.17 gm). Median lobe is slightly enlarged causing impression at bladder. Calcifications seen in parenchyma. Capsule is intact.

The urinary bladder post void residue is significant measures about 150 ml.

IMPRESSION: Mild enlargement of prostate? Benign.

Kindly correlate clinically.
