WHOLE ABDOMEN SONOGRAPHY

Hepatic contour is smooth & span is normal. Parenchymal echotexture is normal. No focal lesion is seen. Intrahepatic biliary radicles are undilated.

Gall bladder is normally distended. Walls are thin. No sludge & calculi seen. No peri GB collection is noted.

Portal vein & CBD are normal in caliber. Pancreas is normal in shape & size. Parenchymal echoes are normal. Pancreatic duct is undilated.

Spleen is normal (7.2 cm). No focal lesion seen.

Right kidney is 9.0 x 3.5 cm & left is 9.4 x 5.0 cm in size. Both kidneys are normal in position & size. Cortical echoes are normal. Pelvicalyceal system is undilated on left side.

Right kidney shows small concretion at mid pole. Mild fullness of right pelvicalyceal system which persists even on postvoid scan.

Both ureters are undilated. No calculi seen at PUJ & UVJ.

Urinary bladder shows normal walls & echofree lumen. No intra luminal lesion or calculi seen. Bilateral urinary jets are present.

Uterus is retroverted & postmenopausal. It measures 6.8 x 3.5 x 3.0 cm. No focal myometrial lesion seen. Cervix is normal. Endometrium is 4 mm.

Both ovaries are normal in size. Right is 2.0 x 1.2 cm & left is 2.0 x 1.3 cm in size. Stroma is normal. No cyst seen.

No free fluid seen in cul-de-sac. No significant Ascitis. No pleural effusion. No significant bowel wall thickening / dilatation or lymphnodes are noted.


[Impression]:

- No hepatobiliary lesion seen.
- Small right renal concretion.
- Mild fullness of right pelvicalyceal system (? post operative).
